POSITION SUMMARY:

The Driver is responsible for driving the 32' food truck or produce truck to and from service destinations and special events.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Drive the 32' food truck and/or produce truck to service destinations and special events.
- Assist during events as needed.
- Transporting staff to events as needed.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
- Obtain patients signature on specific forms.
- Cooperate and coordinate with other staff to ensure efficient deliveries.
- Meet expectations for customer satisfaction and anticipates customer needs.
- Deliver supplies, and equipment in timely, safe and accountable manner.
- Promote Metro's culture by providing quality, comprehensive services to all customers through a team approach.
- Complete daily log in a timely manner.
- Assist in preparing packing lists/delivery tickets.
- Accept assignments willingly.
- Assist in preparing orders for delivery.
- Maintain assigned vehicle in a clean and orderly condition; inform Manager of mechanical problems.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

Education/Experience

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum 2 years' experience driving a delivery truck, food truck or commercial vehicle.

Physical Requirements

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit; use hands to manipulate objects, tools or controls; reach with hands and arms; and talk and hear. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 75 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus. Noise level in the work environment is usually quiet.
